Come away for a day from your busy life to the Bield and enjoy exploring the art of slow stitching in the comfort of our guest lounge, sitting beside the log burning stove and working on our stitching together in silence or with music playing. Slow stitching is the practice of hand with sewing intention and thoughtfulness. There are no rules to slow stitching, the main thing is to have fun with arranging the fabrics and to enjoy the contemplative process of hand stitching.

The focus is not on what you create as this is not The Great British Sewing Bee but rather on the thoughts that arise as you pull the needle through the fabric slowly and calmly. It can provide a space in which to process and ponder on whatever thoughts and images arise as you work slowly. "I am reminded that every day I have the chance to pick up a needle and some thread and add to the story. To stitch together something beautiful and unique, to patch a small scrap of fabric to the story, to the Story of God, that will be retold again and again for all of eternity." – Jerusalem Jackson Greer

The day will start with a time of contemplation in the chapel. Then, after choosing fabrics and being shown some basic hand stitches, we will sit together in the lounge and work on our hand stitching. There will be a short session of body prayer after lunch to loosen us up for a second session of stitching. The day will end at 4pm after a time for sharing and reflection within the safe and sacred space of the Bield.

All fabrics and sewing equipment will be provided but please feel free to bring any fabric that you might wish to work with. We suggest that you wear warm, comfortable clothing as you might want to go for a walk in the grounds. The chapel can be cold in February too.
